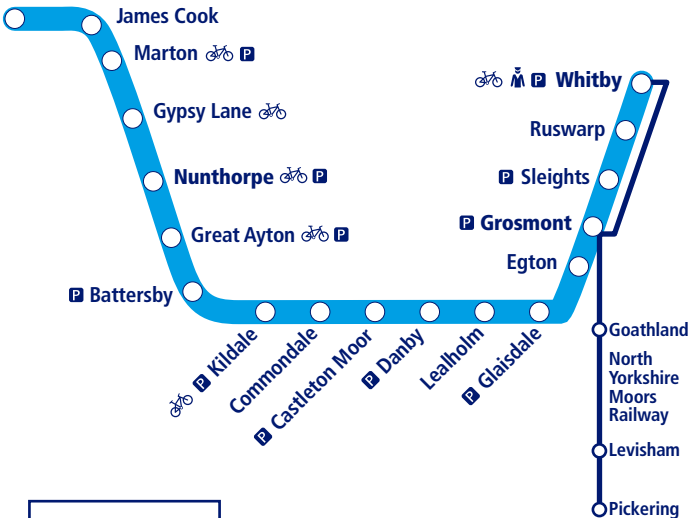

If you travel on a connecting service, change at the next station shown in bold or if you arrive on a connecting service, change at the last station shown in bold, unless a footnote advises otherwise.

All stations have a minimum connection time of 5 minutes unless stated.
